

Cookies policy

With this document, pursuant to articles 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data, as well as the free movement of such data, TESI SPA, data controller, provides users of the site <http://www.tesisquare.com> some information about the cookies used.

What are cookies?

A "cookie" is a small text file created on the user's computer when he accesses a particular site, with the purpose of storing and transporting information. Cookies are sent by a web server (which is the computer on which the visited website is running) to the user's browser (Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, etc.) and stored on the computer of the latter; they are then sent back to the website at the time of subsequent visits. During navigation, the user may receive cookies from different sites on his terminal (so-called "third-party" cookies), set directly by the operators of said websites and used for the purposes and according to the procedures defined by them.

Type of cookies used by this website

Owner's cookies

The site <http://www.tesisquare.com> uses only technical cookies, with respect to which, pursuant to art. 122 of the Privacy Code and the Provision of the Guarantor of 8 May 2014, no consent is required from the interested party.

More precisely, the site uses:

- technical cookies necessary for navigation by the user, indicated below in detail. Without these cookies, the website could not work properly.
- technical cookies that facilitates the user's browsing, recognizing it and avoiding that the brief information on the cookies contained in the banner reappears in the case of links to the site made within the deadline. It is activated by clicking "ok" on the banner.

Deleting this cookie will not save the access to the banner for access made in the 31 days following the first connection to the site.

Third-party cookies

Through the site <http://www.tesisquare.com> some third-party cookies are installed, also profiling, which are activated by clicking "ok" on the banner.

The individual cookies of third parties are reported in detail, as well as the links through which the user can receive more information and request the deactivation of cookies. Please note that the user has the right to revoke the consent that may be given at any time. The withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the treatment based on consent before revocation.

Google Analytics

The Site uses Google Analytics. It is a web analysis service provided by Google Inc. ("Google") that uses cookies that are stored on the user's computer to allow statistical analysis in aggregate form in order to use the website visited.

The data generated by Google Analytics are stored by Google as indicated in the Information, available at the following

Google Analytics installs the following cookies:

1. __utma is a cookie with a maturity of 2 years and is used to determine the unique visitors on the site and is updated at each page view and records the time of the last visit, the previous one and the first recorded, plus a counter of the visits.
2. __utmc is a session cookie that exists only while a visit is in progress and expires when the browser is physically closed.
3. __utmz is a persistent cookie that expires 6 months and contains information on the type of referrer used by the visitor to reach the site (source, campaign and keywords).

Zendesk

The Website uses the Zendesk widget to manage Live Chat to support the services provided. To consult the privacy policy of the company Zendesk, Inc., independent holder of the processing of data relating to the service, please refer to the website

Zendesk Chat uses cookies to save time by eliminating the need to enter the same information several times and to view personalized content in the Service and on subsequent visits to our website. Zendesk Chat saves the unique identification number of each connected device, when a user logs in to the Live Chat service, by entering an encrypted cookie on the user's hard disk. This cookie allows you to move from one page to another within the Service, without having to log in again on each page. When you log out of the service, these cookies are deleted from your computer. For example, the e-mail address can be stored in a cookie that will remain on the computer after disconnection, so that you will only need to type the password the next time you intend to log in.

The Live Chat widget installs the following cookies:

1. __zclid to save the ID used to identify a device during its visit to the site and during a single chat session
2. __zprivacy to store user preferences to disable Live Chat and stop using cookies. The cookie zprivacy cookie is stored during the visit to the site.

Social Networks buttons and widgets

Social buttons are those particular "buttons" on the site that depict icons of social networks (For example, Facebook and Twitter) and allow users who are browsing to interact with a "click" directly with social platforms. The social buttons used by the site are links that refer to the account of the owner on social networks depicted. Through the use of these buttons are therefore not installed on the site third-party cookies.

Method of treatment

The treatment is carried out with automated tools by the owner. No dissemination or communication is made.

Provision of data

Except for technical cookies strictly necessary for normal navigation, the

consent of data is left to the will of the person who decides to browse the site after having read the brief information contained in the appropriate banner and to use the services that involve the installation of cookies. The interested party can therefore avoid the installation of cookies by keeping the banner (refraining from closing it by clicking on the "ok" button), as well as through the special functions available on your browser.

Disabling cookies

Without prejudice to the foregoing in relation to cookies strictly necessary for navigation, the user may delete the other cookies through the functionality provided for this purpose by the Owner through this information or directly through their browser. Each browser has different procedures for managing settings.
